1. oh - awe, Joe - jaw, row - raw, sew - saw
2. boat - bought, choke - chalk, low - law, phone - fawn
3. coat - caught, loan - lawn, tote - taught, pose - paws

Let's practice some sentences that have words using these sounds.

1. Joe saw Moe bought a phone.
2. Fawns pose on the lawn.
3. Moe bought Joe's saw.
