T Sounds Like D

In this lesson, let's contrast the Th/S sounds together. Keep in mind that the position of the tongue is important. For S, the tip tongue should be lower, pointing towards the upper teeth. For Th, the tip of your tongue should come between your front teeth just a little bit.
